DIRECTIONS

GENERAL DISINFECTION IN HOSPITALS, PUBLIC ROOMS AND HOMES.

SANITIZATION OF GLASSWARE, SILVERWARE, DISHES, COOKING UTENSILS. Clean and rinse thoroughly. Then immerse in a sanitizing solution with 1 ounce of disinfectant per 4 gallons of water. The sanitizing solution should be replaced by potable water every day. Do not use for more than one year. Follow the recommendations of your health department.

GENERAL DISINFECTION IN BARBER SHOPS AND BEAUTY PARLORS. Prepare disinfectant solution of 1 1/2 ounce Disinfectant per gallon of water. Clean thoroughly, then soak combs, brushes, scissors in disinfectant solution.

COLD DISINFECTING OF MEDICAL AND SURGICAL INSTRUMENTS. Clean instruments, rinse thoroughly, then immerse in a disinfectant solution of 1 1/2 ounces Disinfectant per gallon of water. Immerse for 10 minutes.

SANITIZATION OF DAIRY EQUIPMENT. Clean and rinse thoroughly. Then immerse in a sanitizing solution containing 1 ounce of Disinfectant per 4 gallons of water. Milk cans and other equipment must be rinsed with potable water before reuse. Follow the recommendations of your health department.

FLANK AND UPPER WASHING. Pour 1 ounce of Bio-Guard into per 4 gallons of water. Use a separate wash towel for each person. Wash thoroughly before using the towel. SANITIZATION OF EQUIPMENT IN FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS, INCLUDING MEAT PLANTS. Clean and rinse equipment thoroughly. Then wet with a solution of 1 ounce Disinfectant per 2 gallons of water. Flush equipment with a potable water rinse before reuse.

DANGER: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eye or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk or egg whites in a large solution. If these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
