The submission referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. The precautionary statements should read as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazard to Human and Domestic Animals
DANGER

Corrosive: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid contamination of food. Remove and wash contaminated clothing.

b. Replace "First Aid" to "Statement of Practical Treatment."

c. Delete the word "milk."

- d. Revise the "Directions" heading to "Directions For Use."
- e. Include the "Storage and Disposal" heading and subheadings "Pesticide Disposal" and "Container Disposal." Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for the correct storage and disposal statements.
- f. Replace the signal word and precautionary statements with the following directly below the ingredient statement on the front panel.

Keep Out of Reach of Children
DANGER

See side panel for additional precautionary statements.


3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL DISINFECTION IN HOSPITALS, PUBLIC ROOMS AND HOMES. After cleaning, apply solution containing 1½ ounce of Disinfectant per gallon of water for usual disinfecting applications (furniture, soils, enameled, tiled, porcelain and smooth finished wood and metal surfaces). For disinfecting surfaces difficult to clean or contagious disease areas, use 1½ ounce per gallon of water (floors, drains, and porous surfaces, such as unfinished or poorly finished metal and wood.)

GENERAL DISINFECTION IN BARBER SHOPS AND BEAUTY PARLORS. Prepare disinfectant solution of 1½ ounce Disinfectant per gallon of water. Clean thoroughly, then soak combs, brushes, scissors in disinfectant solution.

COLD DISINFECTING OF MEDICAL AND SURGICAL INSTRUMENTS. Clean instruments, rinse thoroughly, then immerse in disinfecting solution of 1½ ounces Disinfectant per gallon of water. Immerse for 10 minutes.

FLANK AND UDDER WASHING. Use 1 ounce of Disinfectant per 4 gallons of water. Use a separate clean towel for each cow. Never dip a used towel back into the disinfectant solution. Prepare a fresh solution for each milking. Prepare solutions in non-corrodible containers (stainless steel, plastic). Discard solutions if they become visibly soiled or turbid. To prevent residues in milk, allow udder to air dry or dry with clean towel before attaching to milker.

DANGER: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

Do not reuse empty container.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it in trash collection.
