1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Place the statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" directly above the signal word "Danger."
 - b. Delete the word "milk."
 - c. Delete the statement "Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed" from the "Note to Physician" section.
2. The reduction of ethanol and removal from the active ingredients list is acceptable.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store only in original container. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
