DIRECTIONS

Shut off filter pump, brush wall-clinging algae vigorously, then allow pool water to become stationary. Sprinkle SPOT KILL where algae growth appears, both along pool walls and over surface of water. For heavy algae growth use 2 pounds per 10,000 gallons of water. For light algae growth, use 1 pound per 10,000 gallons of water. Turn on pump after six hours. Do not use pool until chlorine residual falls below 3 ppm.

After treatment (usually the next morning), remove dead algae growths by brushing or scraping. If visible, living algae is still present after brushing, repeat treatment with SPOT KILL.

CAUTION: This product is compatible with all chemicals normally used in swimming pool maintenance, however, THIS CHEMICAL SHOULD NEVER BE MIXED WITH OTHER PRODUCTS AS A DANGEROUS REACTION MAY OCCUR.


Rectangular Pools -- Length times width times depth (in feet) times 7.5 equals gallons.
