**DIRECTIONS**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**TO OPERATE:** Remove cap. Hold container in upright position to spray. Press nozzle directed at insects or area to be sprayed. For best results, spray infested surfaces until wet.

**ANTS, RESISTANT ROACHES, SCORPIONS, WATERBUGS, BLACK WIDOW SPIDERS, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH:** Spray directly on insects where possible. Also spray their trails and wherever insects might congregate such as under sinks, drainboards, in cabinets, cracks and crevices, on baseboards, around door sills, window frames, garbage cans, garages and outhouses. For ants, also spray into their nests. Repeat as necessary.

**FLIES, WASPS, JUNE BUGS, GNATS, CLOVER MITES:** To reduce annoyance from these insects, spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames and other places where these insects may enter. Also treat surfaces where these insects alight or congregate such as on porches, in garages and outhouses and around outside light fixtures. Also treat around outside house foundations.

**FLEAS (Outs de Dwellings):** Apply as a residual spray around outside dwellings to flea-infested areas and around outside pet quarters and animal buildings. Repeat as necessary.

**CARPET BEETLES:** Apply as spot treatment to localized infested floor areas and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks under carpets and treat underside of carpets as well as infested areas to top surface. Also treat crevices, cracks or closets and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary.

**EARWIGS:** Apply as a residual spray to wet infested areas around damp, shady spots, also around rocks, boards and typical hiding places, contacting insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

**DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard containers in trash. Do not contaminate ground water.

**STORAGE:** Store containers in cool, locked area, away from sources of ignition.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as indicated below. We suggest this statement; however, if your toxicological data suggest otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

Note to Physician - Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

2. Add the following use direction to the label:

Do not use this product in the edible product areas or food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

Submit two (2) copies of your revised label and printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until ~~December~~, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 26, 1983.
