HOUSEHOLD INSECTS — House Flies, Fruit Flies, Brown Dog Ticks — 8 Tablespoonfuls per gallon water. Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush around window frames, to base boards under sinks, stove and refrigerator and other areas frequented by pests. Avoid contamination of food, dishes, utensils and water. Do not allow children in treated areas until surfaces are dry.

LAWNS — Lawn Moth Larvae, Sod Webworms, Armyworms, Leafhoppers, Clover Mites, Thrips, Ants, Brown Dog Ticks — One cup (8 fl. ozs.) in 15 gallons water to treat 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn. Mow lawn and water well 1 to 2 days before treatment. Treat lawn in afternoon or early evening. Do not water lawn for 2 to 3 days following treatment. Keep children and animals off treated areas until dry.

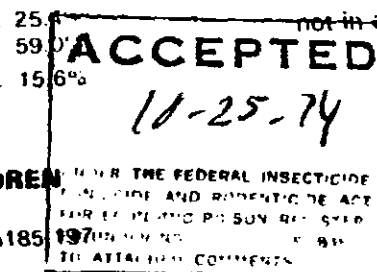
