
FOR CLEANING SOWS: Before placing sows in farrowing pens or crates, scrub down flanks and udder with a lukewarm solution of 1 ounce of disinfectant per gallon of water. Use a softbristled brush. Let sow drain dry and do not rinse until just before farrowing.

SHOE BATH: To help prevent tracking disease organisms into pultry houses, farrowing houses, and hog barns, place a shoe bath with 3 ounces of disinfectant per gallon of water inside the doorway. Scrape off shoes outside doorway and stand in shoe bath for 30 seconds prior to entering. Change shoe bath daily.

## FOR DISINFECTION AND SANITIZATION OF FARM PREMISES AND POULTRY HOUSES:

- 1. Remove all animals, poultry and feeds from premises.
- 2. Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls, and surfaces occupied or traversed by animals or poultry.


