FOR COLORED OR VINYL LINER POOLS. Do not allow undissolved material to lie on the bottom of pools with bleachable surfaces. Predissolve or agitate material with pool brush until active ingredient is completely dissolved.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or safety glasses and rubber gloves when handling this product. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT: Mix only with water. Use clean dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter or other chemicals will start a chemical reaction and generate heat, chlorine gas (and possible fire and explosion). In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood area with large volumes of water, if necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use BloGuard BURN-OUT FR-65 at the rate of 1 bag (1 lb.) per 10,000 gallons of water. Add total amount at one time, broadcasting evenly into the deep end of the pool, when pool is not in use (preferably at night). Monitor the available chlorine level and do not allow swimming until available chlorine falls below 3.0 ppm.

Use BloGuard BURN-OUT FR-65 every other week in most residential pools or weekly for commercial pools or pools with heavy bather loads. Also apply after heavy rain showers.

FOR COLORED OR VINYL LINER POOLS: Do not allow undissolved material to lie on the bottom of pools with bleachable surfaces. Predissolve or agitate material with pool brush until active ingredient is completely dissolved.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container. DO NOT REUSE CONTAINER, but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning or equipment.
