### **DIRECTIONS**

To clean, disinfect and deodorize toilet bowls and urinals.

- 1. Use swab mop to force water from bowl over trap.
- 2. Press swab mop against bowl to remove surplus water, then saturate mop with bowl cleaner while holding bottle or applicator over bowl or urinal.
- 3. Clean unit to remove stains and odorous matter. Swab bowl surfaces thoroughly, especially under the rim.
- 4. Flush commode or urinal several times and rinse applicator thoroughly.

CAUTION: Do not use on sinks, bathtubs or other porcelain enameled surfaces. Use only on vitreous toilets and urinals.
