## **DIRECTIONS**

For light algae growth, use 1 pound per 10,000 gallons of water. Turn on pump after six hours. Do not use pool until chlorine residual falls below 3 ppm.

After treatment (usually the next morning), remove dead algae growths by brushing or scraping. If visible, living algae is still present after brushing, repeat treatment with SPOT-KILL 56 ALGAE DESTROYER. Do not use until chloring residual falls below 3 ppm.
