

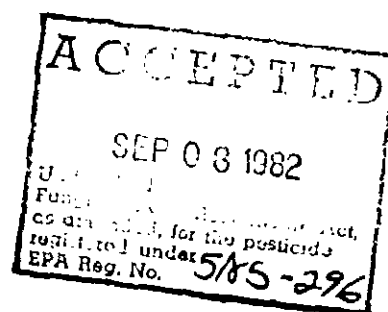


SUPPLEMENTAL LABELING FOR BIO-GUARD L-76 DISINFECTANT

This product may be used for cleaning and sanitizing food service, cleaning and disinfection of selected pre-treated nonporous nonmetallic surfaces.

Prepare fresh use solutions daily. Do not reuse solutions. Discard solutions when they become visibly soiled. For disinfection thoroughly wet the surfaces to be treated. Surfaces must remain moist

for at least 10 min.

This product may be used on porous, nonmetallic, porcelain, linoleum, finished wood furnishings.

To clean and Disinfect Depending on the use of THIS PRODUCT.

Hospitals, Veterinary, Medically related parts of water treatment, disinfection of heavily soiled and disinfect with 1 water (1 oz./2 gal.).

Schools, Industrial, Food processing areas, Public clean surfaces. THIS PRODUCT Alternatively, a part of THIS PRODUCT.

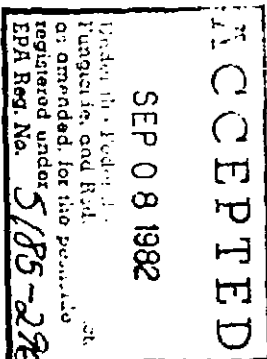

It is also effective against *Escherichia coli* Type A, *Bacillus anthracis* Type A, and *Poliovirus* Type 1.

This product may be used for cleaning and disinfecting hard surfaces. It is not intended for use on food contact surfaces.

CLEANING

To clean and Deodorize or to Preclean Prior to Disinfection. Depending on the soil level of the area to be cleaned, use 1 to 2 oz. of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water.

DISINFECTING

Hospitals, Veterinary Clinics, Nursing Homes, and Other Medically related uses: Use 1 oz. of THIS PRODUCT per 199 parts of water (2 oz. 3 gallons) for one-step cleaning and disinfection of areas with light to medium soil loads. For heavily soiled areas, pre-clean as described above and then disinfect with 1 part of THIS PRODUCT into 255 parts of water (1 oz. 2 gal.).

Schools, Industrial areas, Barber shops, Restrooms, Restaurants, Food and Meat Processing Plants (non-food processing areas), Public rooms, Other Non-Medical uses: Pre-clean surfaces. Then, disinfect with a solution of 1 part of THIS PRODUCT in 443 parts of water (1 oz. 3 1/2 gal. water). Alternatively, clean and disinfect in one operation using 1 part of THIS PRODUCT per 199 parts of water (2 oz. 3 gal.).

For deodorizing garbage cans, garbage trucks, industrial waste receptacles, and garbage handling equipment: It is especially important to pre-clean for the product to perform properly. Then, apply a wetting concentration of 3 oz. of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water (1 part to 40 parts water).

For mildew control: Follow directions for hospital disinfection. Repeat treatment every seven days, or when new growth appears.

THIS PRODUCT may be used through automatic floor scrubbing equipment.

This DISINFECTANT has not been tested for effectiveness against *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* and must not be relied upon when tuberculocidal activity is intended.

THIS PRODUCT must not be used on food contact surfaces.
