DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is a Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Plant Nematode Act product, consistent with its labeling.

SELECT is a slow acting algicide, but gives more effective kill. It may require several days for this product to completely kill the algae in your pool.

Algae Control in Swimming Pools

Observe the desired quantity of this product with water according to the specific directions for the type of treatment desired: Preventive, green algae control or black algae control. Pour the wettable powder into the skimmer or *uniformly* around the edge of the pool. Swimming may resume immediately after application.

SELECT works at normal pool pH operating temperature and functions best in warm water (80 F or higher). It is non-foaming, non-staining, and non-corrosive to pool filters, heaters, pipes, and fittings. It is compatible with chlorine and other commonly used pool chemicals.

Preventive Algae Treatment: To prevent algae in a pool visibly free of algae, use 1.1-3 oz. per 10,000 gallons (0.8 ppm active ingredient). Repeat treatment every 8 to 10 weeks or sooner if algae appears.

Green Algae Control: Apply SELECT at the rate of 2 oz. per 10,000 gallons of pool water (.106 ppm active ingredient) when algae are first visible. Seven days after first treatment, brush algae growth from walls, vacuum out settled algae, and begin the Preventive Algae Treatment.

Black Algae Control: Apply SELECT at the rate of 2-3 oz. per 10,000 gallons of pool water (.16 ppm active ingredient) when algae is first visible. For best results, remove the top of the algae growth daily with a stiff bristled brush and vacuum out settled algae. After seven days, begin the Preventive Algae Treatment.

To Determine Pool Capacity

Rectangular Pools: Length times width times average depth (in feet) times 7.5 equals gallons.

Round and Oval Pools: Long diameter times short diameter times average depth (in feet) times 5.9 equals gallons.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in dry place. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Algicide that cannot be used should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Rinse empty container thoroughly in your pool water, wrap in paper and place in your trash receptacle.

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

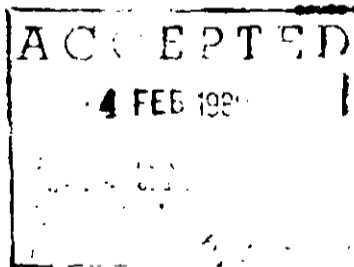
WARNING

Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

First Aid: In case of contact with eyes, flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, get medical attention.

Environmental Hazards: Do not contaminate domestic livestock or fowl or water supplies or lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Do not use treated water to purify or irrigate as SELECT and other pool additives can damage plants.
