

To avoid costly spring problems (algae, cloudy water, high chlorine demand) properly prepare your pool for the winter using LOK UP® WINTER SHOCK II. LOK UP® WINTER SHOCK II oxidizes organic wastes, provides quick dissolving chlorine protection, helps keep pool surfaces clean, and helps protect water during the off season months. May be used in all types of swimming pools.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Before treating the pool, chemically balance the water and adjust pH to 7.4-7.6. Brush and vacuum pool. Backwash the filter and clean skimmer, pump baskets, and filter.

Use two pounds of LOK UP® WINTER SHOCK II per 10,000 gallons of water. Sprinkle into the water around the edges of the pool.

Circulate water for several hours, or preferably overnight, then apply a winter algae preventative following appropriate label directions. Cut off pump. Drain equipment or add a suitable swimming pool antifreeze to the equipment to prevent freeze damage. Install pool cover. A second treatment of WINTER SHOCK II in mesh covered or non-covered pools may be required prior to water freezing (mid-winter).

TO DETERMINE POOL CAPACITY:

RECTANGULAR POOLS — length times width times depth (in feet) times 7.5 equals gallons

ROUND AND OVAL POOLS — Long diameter times short diameter times average depth (in feet) times 5.9 equals gallons

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area, or bury in a safe place.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

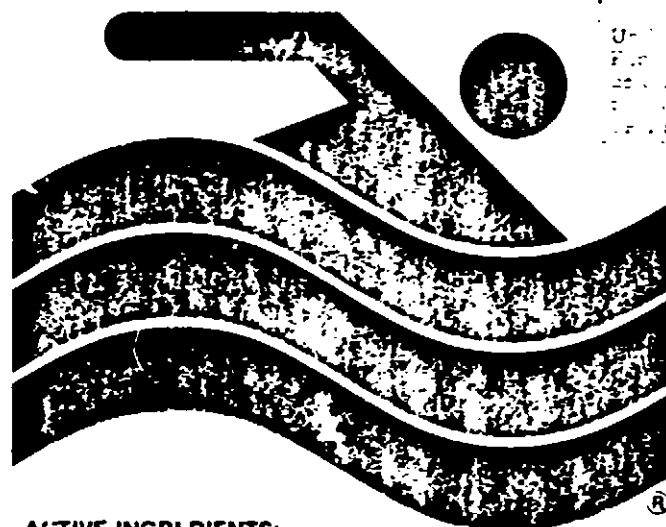
