Vacuum leaves and other foreign matter from the pool. Adjust pH of pool water to 7.4-7.6. Add treatment of chlorine shock per label directions to oxidize water soluble organic wastes. Allow to circulated one hour.

Now apply 8 sunces of this algicide per 5,000 gallons of water. Dilute the concentrate into one or more gallons of water and apply in areas of greatest circulation. The pool may be used again when the chlorine reading drops to 2.0 ppm. In extreme cases, if algae still persists, repeat treatment after 2-4 days.
