DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read entire label and use strictly in accordance with precautionary statements and directions.

This product can only be used in conjunction with the Polaris Precis Spa Feeder. Ensure all spa equipment is working properly. Clean the filter system following manufacturer's directions. Adjust pH to between 7.2-7.6. When using other products as outlined in directions for this product, always follow directions on those products. Place this product in spa feeder, as outlined in the installation instructions below. Spa feeder utilizes a chemical controller that is pre-set at the factory to maintain a bromine residual between 2-4 ppm. To install: Insert canister into opening, lining up canister tabs with keyways. While pushing on canister, rotate clockwise until it stops. Canister is now locked in place. To remove: While pushing on canister, rotate counter-clockwise, pull to remove from opening.

The pump and filter should be operated for at least three hours every day whether spa is used or not. Keep the spa free of leaves and debris. Residential spas and hot tubs should be drained, cleaned and refilled with fresh water every 90 days or as needed.

Reentry into treated spas is prohibited above levels of 8 ppm bromine due to risk of body injury.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep this product dry in original tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Moisture may decompose this product and cause a violent reaction leading to fire and explosion. In case of decomposition, isolate container if possible and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse container, place in trash collection. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Contamination with moisture, organic matter or other chemicals will start a chemical reaction and generate heat, hazardous gas, possible fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood area with large volumes of water.
