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[Spa Silken] [This product] works with [all major] spa water treatment programs to improve the feel and clarity of the water and suppresses algae growth. It enhances soaker comfort by providing soft, clear, silky water. It is especially effective with chlorinated and brominated spas and hot tubs. This product is suitable for [biguanide treated water and] use with mineral treatment systems in spas and hot tubs.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read entire label and use strictly in accordance with precautionary statements and directions.

Initial Application Use or Re-fill:

Apply [6 ounces] {or} [3/4 cups] of [Spa Silken] [this product] for each 200 gallons for spa water. The application of Spa Silken will cause the pH of your water to increase. It will be necessary to also apply [SpaGuard] pH Decreaser to properly balance the pH of your spa water as part of the application of Spa Silken. For each [6 ounces] {or} [3/4 cups] of [Spa Silken] [this product], [3 ounces] {or} [6 Tablespoons] of [SpaGuard] pH Decreaser will be needed.

The sequence of the application is: 1/2 of the Spa Silken total dosage, all of the pH Decreaser dosage followed by the remaining 1/2 of the Spa Silken total dosage. All applications should be done with the circulation pump operating. Each product is sprinkled into the area of the water with the most agitation. After each addition of product, be sure any undissolved granules are brushed off spa surfaces. Allow the water to circulate for 15 minutes between each application and for 20 to 30 minutes following the last application. Spa use may resume once this circulation time is finished.

Maintenance:

Residential spas should be drained and refilled every 60 to 90 days. Commercial spas should follow local guidelines for refill frequency. Follow refill directions above after addition of refill water. Maintenance applications of [Spa Silken] [this product] may be needed if spa is not refilled frequently. Taking a sample of your spa water to your [SpaGuard [Authorized]] Dealer for testing each month is recommended.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in original container and place in locked storage area. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying.
