For control of algae in swimming pools. Do not use in fish ponds or lily pools. In pool dilutions, KEM ALGATROL is nonflammable, non-volatile, odorless and noncorrosive to pumps and piping.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

##### DANGER

Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not breathe spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Corrosive. Causes eye and skin damage. Wear goggles or a face shield and rubber gloves when handling.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically, may be needed. If persistent, convulsions may be controlled by the cautious intravenous injection of a short-acting barbiturate drug.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF INHALED:** Remove the victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush the eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

First application should be made when the pool is being filled and before algae has formed. Use at the rate of one gallon of KEM ALGATROL in each 20,000 gallons of pool capacity. Pour KEM ALGATROL directly into pool.

**IMPORTANT:** Avoid necessity of a cleaning problem by using KEM ALGATROL when pool is being filled first time.

For subsequent treatment, add one gallon of KEM ALGATROL to each 50,000 gallons of pool water every five to seven days. In cool weather, use less often—more often in warm, sunny weather.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE: KEEP CONTAINER CLOSED.**

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

#### CONTAINER DISPOSAL

**PLASTIC CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of the smoke.

#### METAL CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities.
