**DIRECTIONS**

Excellent for cleaning and deodorizing toilets and urinals. For disinfecting urinals, bathroom fixtures, showers and porcelain, use 6 oz. to a quart of water. With this product wet the surfaces to be cleaned thoroughly and let stand for 10 minutes. Then scrub and rinse with clean water. Empty toilet of all water before pouring bowl cleaner in. For cleaning urinals and toilets, pour 4 to 6 oz. directly into bowl and let stand for a few minutes. Then swab sides and below water line with a bowl mop.

**SWIMMING POOL SURFACES:** This product will remove soap film, scum, mildew stain and certain mineral deposits. Apply to walls, gutters and floors at full strength. Let stand for 10 minutes. Then dilute product 3 to 1 with water and scrub area to be cleaned with a bristle brush. Wear rubber gloves and protect eyes when applying in this manner. Rinse empty container with water and discard it. For mildew stain removal repeat application weekly.

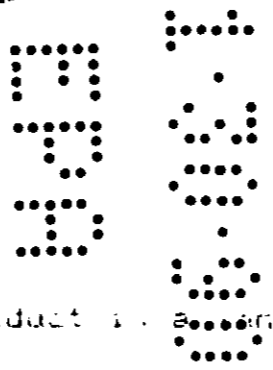

**FOR CLEANING**

**Lightly soiled areas** - Surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1/2 ounce of PINE 17 per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

**Heavily soiled areas** - Mop or brush surface with a solution containing 1 - 2 ounces of PINE 17 per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

#### **GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION**

To disinfect walls, floors, and other hard non-porous surfaces in schools, restaurants, rest rooms, and other public areas, mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 1/2 ounce of PINE 17 per gallon of water so as to maintain thoroughly wetted surface for 10 minutes. All soiled surfaces must be pre-cleaned prior to disinfection (follow directions for cleaning). Those surfaces which may later come in contact with food (e.g., tables) must be rinsed with clear water of drinking quality. Do not use food solution. For general disinfection of *Salmonella* spp. a solution of 1/2 ounce of PINE 17 per 100 parts water will disinfect rapidly. Disinfect for 10 minutes. For disinfection of *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Shigella* spp. a solution of 1/2 ounce of PINE 17 per 100 parts water will disinfect for 10 minutes.
