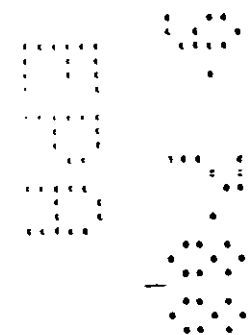

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. 5197-34

TO CLEAN TOILET BOWLS: It is not necessary to remove water from bowl. Hold mop over bowl, pour on 1 ounce of KEMSQL. Swab entire inside area of bowl. Flush toilet and rinse mop.

URINALS: Hold mop over trap. Pour on 1 ounce of KEMSQL. Swab thoroughly, wetting entire surface. Remove screen from trap and pour 1 to 2 ounces around outlet and into drain, swab drain area, replace screen, and flush.

TO DISINFECT:

1. Remove water from the bowl by forcing it over the trap with the applicator.
2. Remove excess water from the applicator by pressing it against the side of the bowl.
3. Pour 1 ounce KEMSQL Bowl Renovator with Bleach on the applicator.
4. Clean the entire unit, especially under the rim at the water outlets. Allow to remain 10 minutes.
5. Flush and rinse out the applicator.

A preliminary cleaning is necessary for the removal of gross filth prior to disinfection.

NOTE: May be used in systems with septic tank.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

IMPORTANT: Do not use or allow to splash on porcelain-coated steel or chrome-plated fixtures, stainless, aluminum or galvanized (zinc) fittings, or on plastic laminates.

COLUMN 3

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Keep container closed.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
