DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read and follow all directions on label and use this product in a manner consistent with the directions on the labeling.

Apply to all insects to be controlled. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening at insect and press down button to spray.

CONTROL HOUSEHOLD PESTS

For Houseflies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats: Close all doors and windows. Stand in doorway, aim upward, direct spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the

Treated areas should be kept closed for at least 15 minutes. Re-occupy the area when treatment is completed.

For Crawling Insects: Roaches, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes: Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. **Ants:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary. **Wasps:** Apply in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places. Contact as many insects as possible. Repeat if necessary.

OUTDOORS TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS

Reduce mosquitoes, gnats (midges), houseflies, biting flies, and small flying moths by spraying their resting areas. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes, and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios with a similar method. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

NOTE: Remove pets, birds, and cover or remove fish aquariums before using.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Do not swallow, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing the spray mist. Provide adequate ventilation of the area being sprayed. Contact with skin, eyes and clothing should be avoided. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of food, utensils and food preparation areas. Should poisoning occur, get prompt medical attention.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting; get prompt medical attention.

IF INHALED: Move the person to fresh air and treat symptomatically.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap thoroughly. If skin irritation persists, see a physician.

IF IN EYES: Flush with water for fifteen minutes, then see a physician immediately.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F. 754 C. may cause bursting. Never throw the container into a fire or incinerator.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Replace the cap and securely wrap the original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
