The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are printed, delete "alkyl homolog of Cinerin 1" from the ingredient statement. It no longer accurately describes the allethrin used in this formulation.

We are not accepting the labels marked Restricted Use since the outdoor uses on this pesticide are not subject to restricted classification. You may continue to distribute this pesticide with the outdoor use previously approved provided the appropriate ENVIRONMENTAL statement from the resmethrin standard is also a part of the label:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes). Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish and to aquatic organisms in adjacent waters. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

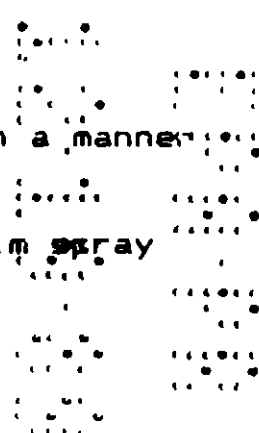

CONTROL HOUSEHOLD PESTS

For Houseflies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

For Crawling Insects: Roaches, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes: Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Wasps: Apply in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places. Contact as many insects as possible. Repeat if necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Harmful if swallowed. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting; get prompt medical attention.

IF INHALED: Move the person to fresh air and treat symptomatically.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap thoroughly. If skin irritation persists, see a physician.

IF IN EYES: Flush with water for fifteen minutes, then see a physician immediately.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS
