Treating Citrus For Control of Blue and Green Mold

In spray type application dilute one part Foamex with nine or nineteen parts water to obtain 2% or 1% sodium ortho-phenyl-phenate tetrahydrate, respectively. Apply by spraying over rolling brushes at a rate of one gallon of diluted Foamex per 3,000 lbs. of fruit.

In immersion type bin dumpers the tank should be charged with 0.3% sodium ortho-phenylphenate tetrahydrate. Use one part Foamex to each 65.7 parts of water needed to charge the tank. When the tank level drops during operation, recharge by adding one part of Foamex to each 65.7 parts of make-up water added. Fruit should be immersed in Foamex for a minimum of two minutes and a maximum of three minutes and must be rinsed with fresh water after treatment.
