### **USE DIRECTIONS**

(Note: Use soft water for dilution)

### For Cleaning

LIGHTLY SOILED AREAS — surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1 ounce of CLEANSAN 537 per 5 gallons of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

HEAVILY SOILED AREAS — mop or brush soiled surface with a solution containing 2-3 ounces of CLEANSAN 537 per 5 gallons of water. Rir cleaned surface with fresh water.

## **General Purpose Disinfection**

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in food processing plants, restaurants, rest rooms and other public areas, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 1 ounce of CLEANSAN 537 per 5 gallons of water. ### Sanitization

To sanitize walls, floors and equipment in food processing plants, first clean thoroughly with a solution containing  $\frac{3}{4}$  ounce of CLEANSAN 537 per 5 gallons of water. If surface is heavily soiled, use CLEANSAN 537 at a rate of 2-3 ounces per 5 gallons to insure thorough cleaning. ### Deodorization
