Dear Dr. Radnia:

The referenced labeling, submitted in connection with registration under the FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five (5) copies of the finished printed labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- The first two sentences of the Environmental Hazard section must be revised to read, "Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water by disposal of equipment washwaters."
- The Application Instructions should be incorporated into the Directions For Use, where the Directions For Use currently appear on the label.
