For lemons and small citrus fruits apply wax at the rate of 1 gallon per 11,500 to 12,000 lbs. of fruit through a spray and brush waxer.

For oranges and grapefruit apply wax at the rate of 1 gallon per 11,000 lbs. of fruit through a spray and brush waxer.


