1. Place the signal word above the "Keep Out Of The Reach Of Children" statement on the front panel.
2. Change "Practical Treatment" to "Statement of Practical Treatment".
3. Place the statement "It is unlawful to use this product on nonaluminum . . . or lower drive unit of such vessel" immediately after the statement "It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."
4. Include the following container disposal statement on your label under the Storage and Disposal section.

Container Disposal

Triple rinse container if intended for recycling or reconditioning. Empty paint containers with small amounts of dried residue must be disposed of in a sanitary landfill (or if required by Federal, State or local regulations, handled as a hazardous waste).
