- d. Include the statement "IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get Medical Attention.
- e. Change the "IF SWALLOWED" statement to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol. Get Medical Attention.
- f. Include the signal word "DANGER" and the statement "Keep Out of Reach Of Children to fall directly below the ingredient statement. The signal word must be placed immediately below the child hazard warning statement.
- g. The product name should be increased in type size to be more prominent. It is suggested that the product name be at least the same size as the child hazard warning statement.

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
