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FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Self-feed continuously as the sole source of salt to cattle in order that the following amounts will be consumed based on body weight (for best results treated animals should get 1/4 gram Phenothiazine per 100 lbs body weight).

Live Weight	Feed
400 lbs.	4 oz. per head daily
600 lbs.	6 oz. per head daily
800 lbs.	8 oz. per head daily
1000 lbs. and over	10 oz. per head daily

Note: Each 1 oz. supplies 1/4 gm. Phenothiazine.

This treatment will not affect the population of existing adult flies.

WARNING: DO NOT FEED TO LACTATING DAIRY ANIMALS. OCCASIONAL SENSITIVITY TO PHENOTHIAZINE HAS BEEN REPORTED IN CATTLE.

Since face flies migrate from farm to farm, it is essential that the larvicide program be carried out on an area basis to assist in reduction of the adult face fly population.
