

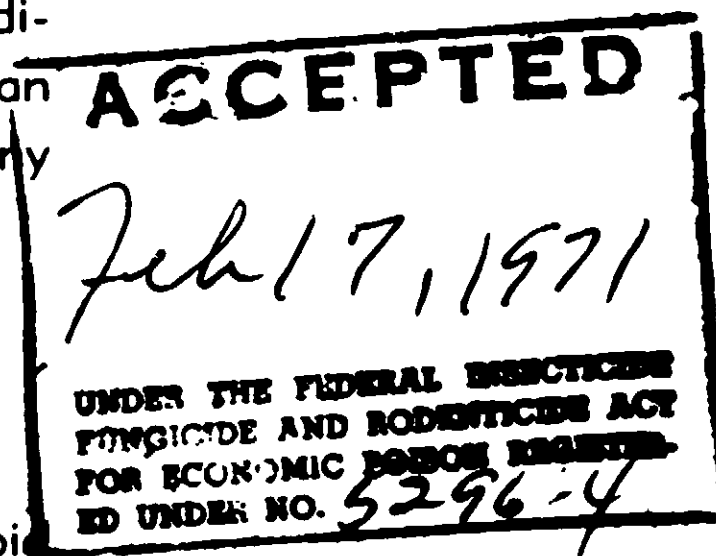
Dauban contains a volatile fungistatic and bacteriostatic chemical which gives immediate as well as longer lasting activity. Dauban is effective in restricting the growth of many common bacteria and fungi.

CAUTION

Keep Dauban out of reach of children. Avoid inhalation of vapors from Dauban. If nausea occurs, consult a physician. Wash hands after handling Dauban and before eating. May be harmful if swallowed. Use only where inhalation of fumes will be minimal.

SUGGESTED APPLICATIONS

- Hospital bags.
- Disposal bags for used bandages and dressings.
- Liners for trash and disposal cans.
- Bags for retarding the growth of microorganisms on articles such as brushes, combs, telephones, etc.
- Wrapping paper for control of mildew and fungal growth, as needed in the preservation of leather, cotton, or wool goods, such as shoes, blankets, and sheets during storage.

HOW TO USE DAUBAN

To protect items or materials wrap them in Dauban and place them in containers, or place them in containers together with the recommended amount of Dauban. Use at a rate of at least two square feet of Dauban per cubic foot of space. Seal containers to make them as airtight as possible. Sealing of the container is essential since slow leakage of the active vapor will limit shelf-life. Intimate contact between Dauban and the packaged item or material is not necessary since the volatile ingredients will diffuse throughout the package. Packages should be kept closed to retain the active vapors.

Dauban should be used immediately after removal from its wrappings. Protection starts when contaminated articles have been exposed to Dauban paper for as little as two hours. In order to assure best performance Dauban should not be re-used and should be discarded if container is repeatedly opened.
