MACLEAN'S 40% PENTA

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To make a 50 ready-to-use solution, mix one part of this concentrate with ten parts by volume of a suitable petroleum solvent such as mineral spirits or kerosene.

Maclean's 40% Penta is a concentrate, do not use without diluting.

WOOD PRESERVATION

To protect wood that is to be placed in contact with the soil use this material diluted with kerosene, stove oil, or other suitable solvents at a dilution of one part Penta to nine parts solvent. Brush on this material using two coats, one 24 hours after the first coat. For best protection soak the posts in a container of Penta solution that will allow the posts to be raised two inches above the soil line when the posts are placed in the soil. Allow the posts to soak for at least 5 minutes for each inch of stock. Example: 4" x 2 post should be soaked for 10 minutes. Posts for treating should be free of bark and well seasoned. On old construction, remove decayed wood at least two feet from decay, paint or spray the surface making sure to force the material in all cracks and end grain. On wood that is to be painted use mineral spirits as a diluent and allow at least 72 hours for drying before painting.
