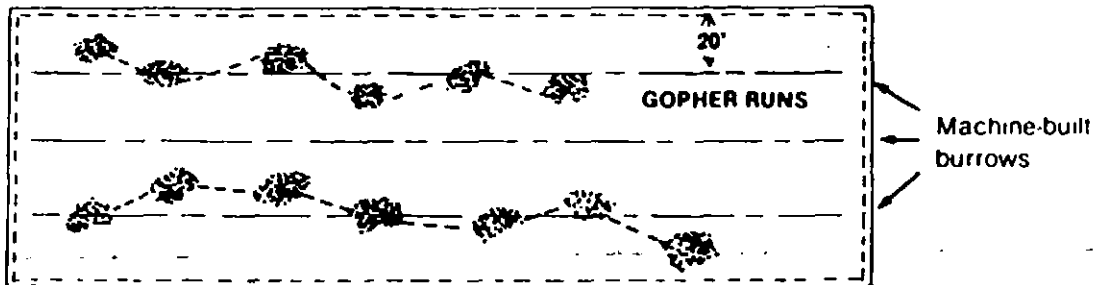


ARTIFICIAL BURROW-BUILDER METHOD

When treating extensive areas, "BURROW BUILDERS" may be used. Follow manufacturer's instructions for the equipment used to apply pocket gopher bait. Make sure that machine-built burrows intersect pocket gopher burrows at the depth at which gophers have been tunneling. For greater efficiency of treatment, machine-built burrows should intersect as many gopher tunnels as possible at right angles. Apply bait at a rate of 1 to 2 pounds per acre, using a 25' to 30' row spacing interval. Apply only when soil condition is proper to insure formation of a good artificial burrow.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children, pets and domestic animals.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spilled bait, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping and loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.
