WHY:

The natural beauty of any lawn may be marred by unsightly weeds. Many "broad-leaved" or what are also called "non-grassy" weeds and creeping weeds, may invade the best managed lawn. Prompt destruction of these weeds is most important. The use of WEEDKILL in the granular form avoids the hazards of spray drift.

YARROW

WHEN:

This product will kill all bentgrass lawns, DO NOT APPLY. May be used with caution on mixed-grass lawns containing bentgrass at ONE HALF RATE ONLY during Spring and Fall, when grasses are in good condition.

The best time to destroy weeds is when they are growing actively. The soil should be moist. The day warm and calm. Delay mowing for 2 days before and after application. Spring: Wait 10 days after watering, a rain fall, or whenever the grass has turned green. New, heavy application when rain is impending. In the event of a shower the same day, a repeat treatment may be necessary.

Applications made during cold weather may have to be repeated to get best results.

Treat a new lawn only after grasses are well developed and it has been mowed at least twice.

Do not apply immediately before or after seeding.

SHEEP SORREL

HOW:

SPOT TREATMENT: Merely sprinkle WEEDKILL on moist foliage.

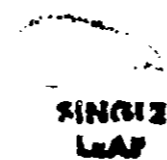

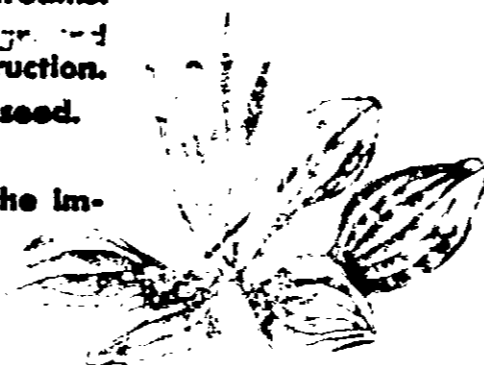

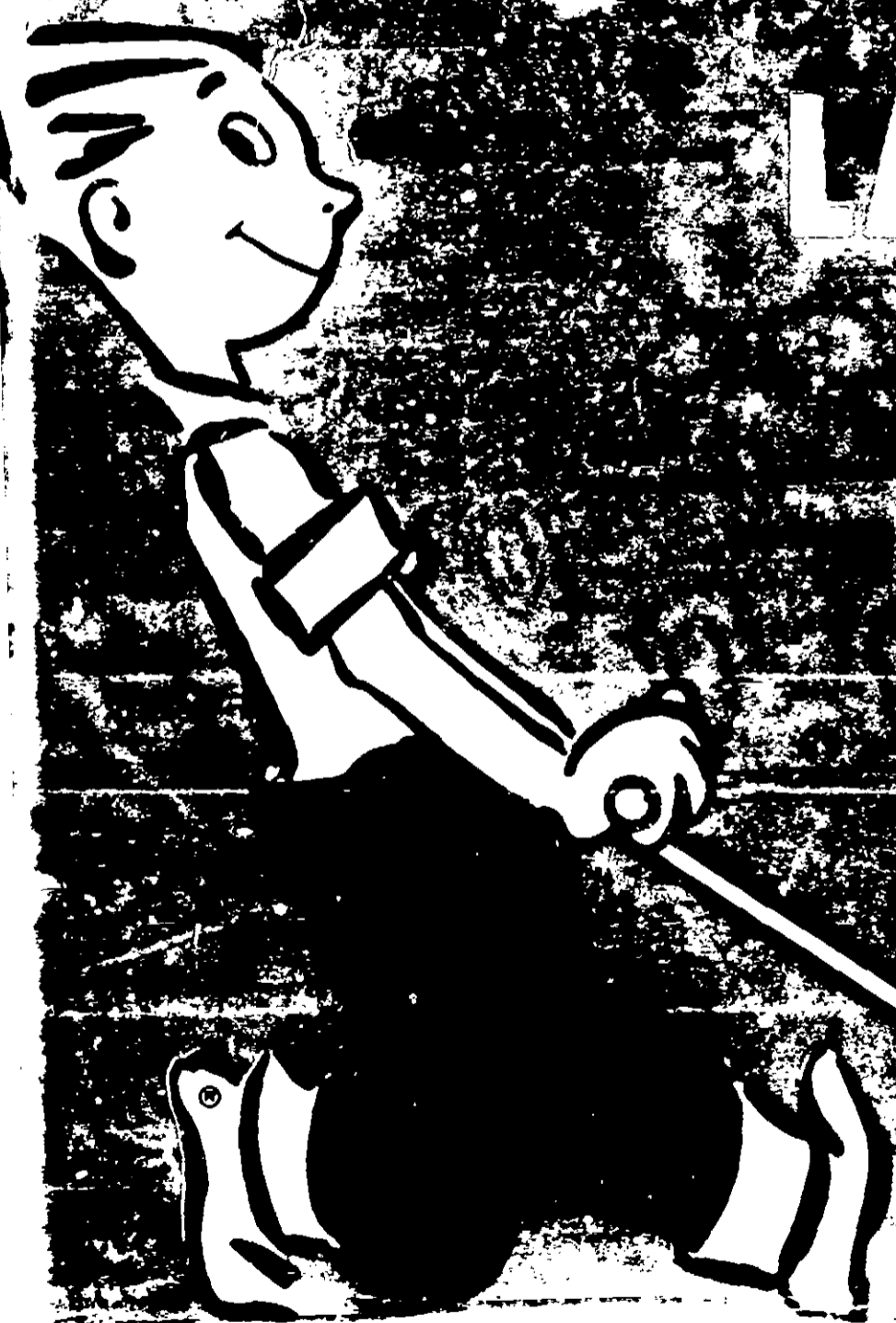
