### DIRECTIONS

Wash and rinse prior to sanitizing. To sanitize milk utensils, equipment use 2 oz. Solventol #304 in 6 gallons water (100 ppm available chlorine). Brush, immerse, spray or circulate (CIP). Rinse with water. If no facilities are available to determine a reduction to less than 50 ppm available chlorine in the sanitizing solutions, start with a 200 ppm available chlorine solution.

NOTE: Contact time. The laws of some states require that utensils and equipment remain in contact with the germicidal solution for at least 2 minutes. Solventol #304 fulfills the criteria of Appendix F as revised March 12, 1966, the Milk Ordinance and Code, 1953 recommendations of the U.S. Public Health Service when tested by Chambers method. Replace cover, store in cool, dry place.
