

PINE TYPE DISINFECTANT

RECOMMENDED USES

For mopping floors and wiping walls use $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ cup to a gallon of water of PINE TYPE DISINFECTANT. Use full strength for stubborn spots or stains.

LAUNDRY—To aid in cleaning and deodorizing add $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of PINE TYPE DISINFECTANT to soap or detergent. For stains and spots difficult to clean use full strength by pre-dampening with PINE TYPE DISINFECTANT before adding to regular wash. As a pre-soak prior to routine laundering of Diapers add $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of PINE TYPE DISINFECTANT to a gallon of water.

BATHROOM—For killing household germs wash Tub, Toilet, Sink and Tile with $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ cup per gallon of water, leaving bathroom with a smell of freshness.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: Steam Distilled Pine Oil 30%, Soap 10%, Isopropyl Alcohol 10%.

INERT INGREDIENTS: 50%

CAUTION: Contains Pine Oil, an eye irritant in case of contact with eyes, flush immediately with water. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call Physician immediately. Avoid contact with food. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
