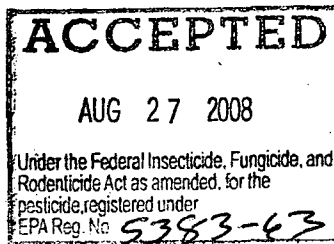

PRODUCT: The following are suggested application levels given for the various application. All suggestions are given for Polyphase®AF1.

USE: In order to determine the most effective given use field trials are suggested.

GENERAL PRECA

Do not apply this product in a way that Polyphase®AF1 is not to be used in food.

APPLICAT

PAINTS AND STAINS: Generally use one hundred gallons. For hot, humid use 0.1-0.4% (1-4 pounds). For wood use Polyphase®AF1.

PLASTICS: Use in PVC plastics surface level of 0.5-2.5%.

CUTTING OILS: Use 0.05-0.5%

WOOD: For above ground use only a sapstain control, use 0.5% within 24 hours apply to wood surfaces that come into contact.

TEXTILES: Use 0.1-1.0% for coatings
PAPER COATINGS: Use in aqueous solution 0.05-0.3%.

CANVAS AND CORDAGE: Use 0.5-2%

ADHESIVES: Use 0.05-0.2%

INKS: Use 0.05-3.0%

STORAG
