

**ENVIRONMENT**

**APPLICATION**

Mergal®174P is sold for industrial use only. It is a metallic organic microbiocide designed for use in the prevention of deterioration. Examples of such products include pigments, drilling additives. It is supplied as a powder where water is a primary component. Not for use in the total weight of the formulation. Mergal®174P is not for use in the manufacturing process. It should not be stored at 125°F (52°C) for prolonged periods of time. Do not use in systems with a pH below 3.

NOTE: All amino based products may be used. It is encouraged to check for color stability.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.  
PESTICIDE STORAGE: Do not store near heat, fire, or freezing temperatures for prolonged periods. Do not store in unlined metal containers.
