Dear Mr. Krygsman,

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) is acceptable with the following conditions.

Proposed Amendment

Adding new use pattern, Metalworking Fluids .

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

- 1.) Revise the 4th statement under the "Precautionary Statements" to read "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet."
- 2.) According to the 3-Iodo-2-Propynl Butyl Carbamate (IPBC) RED, all end-use products supporting occupational uses must list baseline personal protection equipment by adding the following text:

Personal Protection Equipment:

"Applicators and other handlers must wear long sleeve shirt, long pants, chemical-resistant gloves, and shoes plus socks. Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions exist for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry."

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User Safety Requirements

Users must wash han ds before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Users must remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

Users must remove personal protective equipment immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly.


- 3.) The first aid statements must be organized so that the most severe routes of exposure, as demonstrated by the toxicity classification, are listed first. Therefore, reorganize the list to read "If in Eyes, If Swallo wed, If Inhaled, If on skin or clothing."
- 4.) The "Note to Physician" must be revised by deleting the statement, "Probable mucosal damage may contrain dicate the use of gastric lavage since this product is not corrosive or classified as category I for the systemic routes of toxicity (acute oral, dermal, or inhalation toxicity).
- 5.) According to PR Notice 83-3, Pesticide Disposal statements are based on a product's acute toxicology profile and/or the individual components of the formulation (active and inerts) classification as a toxic hazardous waste. Since this product's formulation does not meet the criteria of a toxic waste, you must revise these statements to read "Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility."
- 6.) Revise the "Pesticide Storage" statements to be in compliance with PR Notice 2000-5, Mandatory Labeling by stating "Do not store Polyphast at ... Drums must be ..."
- 7.) The "Container Disposal" statements must be updated to be in compliance with PR Notice 2007-4, Container Rule by adding the statements, "Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container."

General Comments

A stamped accepted label with conditions is enclosed for your records. Submit a copy of your final printed label before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3 (c) (5) and section 4 (a) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

If the above conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6 (e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
