

Mergal®186-II is sold for industrial use only. Mergal®186-II is a liquid, water soluble organic preservative designed for use in aqueous based systems such as latex paints, resin emulsions, pigment slurries, dispersed colors, joint cements, adhesives (that do not contact food or food packaging) and metal working fluids. For systems where water is the primary component, Mergal®186-II will generally impart preservative properties at levels of 0.1%-0.3% on a weight to weight basis (0.016-0.48 ounces per pound of product to be protected) based on the finished formula weight. Mergal®186-II is a liquid product that can be added to the production material at any point in the manufacturing process. It is not suggested for use in systems with a pH below 7.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
PESTICIDE STORAGE: Do not store at freezing temperatures for prolonged periods.
