The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Octhilinone (OIT) RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** yet being reregistered under section 4(g) of FIFRA.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this amendment or the next printing of the label, whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label

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constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6.

Mergal S90 is an antimicrobial preservative for control of fungi and algae growing on paints, coatings, plasters, sealants, and fillers used for architectural products, finishes and special purpose coatings.

Typically, Mergal S90 should be added at the beginning of the formulation process while mixing of the final product (paint, plaster, etc.) to assure uniform distribution of the Mergal S90.

PAINTS AND COATING* MATERIALS: (0.2-2.0%) add 2-20 lbs. (0.9-9.0 kg.) of Mergal S90 to each 1000 lbs. (453 kg.) of paint.

PLASTERS* AND STUCCOS: (0.1-1.0) add 1-10 lbs. (0.45-4.5 kg.) of Mergal S90 to each 1000 lbs. (453 kg.) of plasters.

SEALANTS*, **CAULKS AND FILLERS***: (0.1-1.5%) add 1-15 lbs. (0.45-6.8 kg.) of Mergal S90 to each 1000 lbs. (453 kg.) of sealant or filler.

Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
