Troy Mergal®K9N is a microbiocide that is effective against bacteria, yeasts, molds and algae. It is used as an industrial microbiocide for adhesives, building materials, pigment dispersions, emulsions, paints and coatings.

Troy Mergal®K9N is used to control bacteria and fungi in dispersed pigments such as kaolin clay, montmorillite clay, titanium dioxide, calcium carbonate, calcium sulfate, barium sulfate, and magnesium silicate used in paint and paper production. Typical emulsions include printing components (inks, resins, waxes, and surfactants). Building materials include mastics, caulks, joint cements, spackling, plasters and stuccos. Use as an in-can preservative in paints and coatings.

It is best if Troy Mergal NON is added to the initial phase of production, however, if excessive temperatures or pH values occur, addition at the end of the manufacturing process is recommended.

Typical usage rates are 0.05-0.40% based on the total weight of the formulation:
