

- c. Revise the precautionary statements to read:

“Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.”

- d. Revise the first aid statements to ensure that it states the following:

If swallowed:

- Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin:

- e. Revise the “User Safety Recommendations” (not required based upon the acute toxicity/ primary irritation studies) to delete the first item of these statements because it duplicates parts of the required precautionary statements.
3. Revise the basic CSF (item 13b) to change the percentage active ingredient, 3-iodo-2-propynyl butyl carbamate to 21.6 (so that it agrees with the revised label claim as stated in 2b above), and submit revised copies to the Agency before you release the product for sale.
4. Submit three (3) copies of the revised final printed label bearing the aforementioned revisions prior to releasing this product for sale.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A label stamped "accepted with comments" is enclosed for your records.

TEXTILES: Use for coatings or dyes at 0.5-1.0%.

PAPER COATINGS: Use in aqueous and solvent systems at 0.125-0.25%.

CANVAS AND CORDAGE: Generally use 0.125-0.25%.

ADHESIVES: Use 0.125-2.5%.

INKS: Use 0.25-2.5%.

JOINT CEMENTS: Generally use 0.125-0.25%.

ROOF COATINGS: Generally use 1.5-5%.

STUCCO AND EIFS COATINGS: Generally use 1.5-5%.
