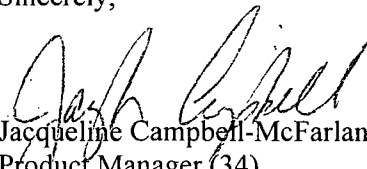

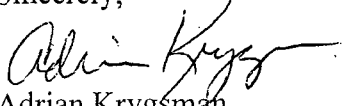

If articles have been treated with Troyguard IP12 do not use them as components in materials used in food packaging and food-holding.

For wood composites only use for above ground applications. Suggested application levels are based on laboratory and field evaluations and are typical for the use areas indicated. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
