

ENVIRONMENT

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic life. Do not discharge this product into lakes, streams, rivers, or other bodies of water, unless in accordance with the requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and writing prior to discharge. DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this pesticide in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that causes injury to humans or animals.

APPLICATION

PAINTS: Generally use 0.6-2.0%. For hot, humid climates use 1.0-2.0%.
WOOD: For above ground use only at rates of 0.2-1.0%. For one-minute dip at ambient temperatures in a solution, the concentration should be adequate to control the development of mold and mildew on sawn lumber, a concentration of 1.0% is suggested. For use on wood surfaces that come in contact with skin, the contact surface should be coated with a varnish or paint. For use on Troyshield®LA33. Wood protective stains with fungicide should be used.
CUTTING OILS: Use 0.1-1.0%.
TEXTILES: Use for coatings or dyes at 0.2-1.0%.
PLASTICS: For use in PVC plastics such as pipes and fittings at 1.0-4.0%. Troyshield®LA33 should not be used on plastics that come in contact with food.
IN-CAN PRESERVATIVE: Troyshield®LA33 should not be used on food use agricultural products such as fertilizers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
PESTICIDE STORAGE: This material has a flash point below 100°F. Store at temperatures below 100°F. Storage temperatures below 50°F are suggested.
