

- b. Revise the precautionary statements to read as follows:

"Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses). Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.
