- To remove "Contains petroleum distillates- vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia"


General Comments:

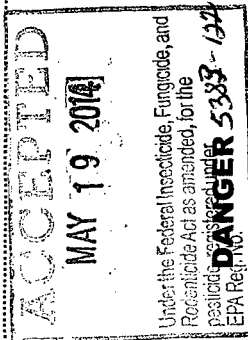
