

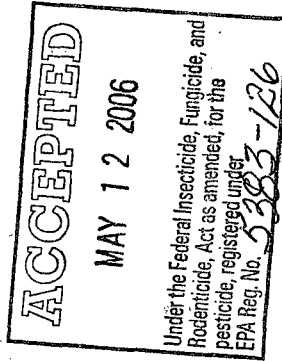

A level of 0.6% MICROPEL 5 PVC based on total weight of the final treated product will give excellent control against bacteria and mold organisms in treated articles. For certain items which may be subjected to extended outdoor weathering, such as marine upholstery, swimming pool liners, tarpaulins, landau tops, a level of 1% should be evaluated.

MICROPEL 5 PVC should not be used on items which come into contact with food stuffs nor items of clothing or infant wear.

NOTE: Please refer to instructional bulletins for additional information on the use of this product.
