DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this pesticide with food stuffs nor items of clothing or linings of coatings, paper and paperboard and adhesives make claims of antimicrobial activity other than bacteria and mold in the treated article. MICROPEL 2 ESO specifically designed for use also be used as a preservative in plastic products, textiles and textile fibers, and resin, latex and foams. APPLICATION

MICROPEL 2 ESO is suggested for polyvinyl chloride, polyurethane, silicone and latex polymers. Applications include: Vinyl film and sheeting, waterbed liners, shower curtains, protective coatings, paper and paperboard and adhesives, foam gaskets, floor moldings. Plastics - vinyl, polyethylene, polypropylene, polycarbonate, coated fabrics, adhesives for vinyl, ceramic tile, pipe sealants, sail cloth. Molded goods - vinyl, polyethylene, polypropylene, polycarbonate, automotive parts, shoe soles. Coated fabrics - vinyl, polyethylene, polypropylene, polycarbonate, ticking, backlit signs, awnings, tents, tarpaulins. Coatings/Sealants - industrial urethane coatings, caulks for bathroom and industrial use, carpet underlay, gaskets, shoe soles. STORAGE
