Adhesi ves: 0.5-1.5% (or 0.5 lbs/100 lbs adhesive)
Interior/Exterior Coatings: 0.5-1.5% (or 0.5 lbs/100 lbs adhesive)
Caulks/Grouts/Sealants: 0.5-1.5% (or 0.5 lbs/100 lbs adhesive)

Product should be agitated well to ensure thorough mixing of EX1050.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Storage between 90°F (32°C) and 32°F (0°C) is suggested.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticides, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of federal law.
