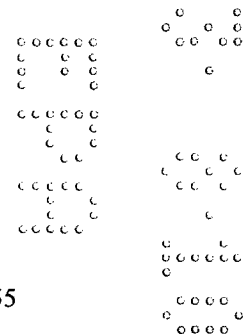

**Interior/Exterior Coatings:** 0.5%-1.5% (or 0.5lbs/100 adhesive)

**Caulks/Grouts/Sealants:** 0.5% 1.5% (or 0.5lbs/100 adhesive)

Product should be agitated well to ensure thorough mixing of Troy EX 1050.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Storage between 90°F (32°C) and 32°F (0°C) is suggested.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticides, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of federal law. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
