This product is toxic to fish. APPLICATION

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons.

The following are suggested use levels for Troy EX 1050. Typically use levels for the various applications indicate the approximate levels for the particular application. All suggested use rates are in percentage by weight and refer to the product Troy EX 1050. In order to determine the most effective use level for Troy EX 1050 in a given use, field trials are suggested.

Adhesives:

0.5%-1.5% (or 0.5lbs/100lbs adhesive)

Interior/Exterior Coatings:

0.5%-1.5% (or 0.5lbs/100 adhesive)

Caulks/Grouts/Sealants:

0.5% 1.5% (or 0.5lbs/100 adhesive)

Product should be agitated well to ensure thorough mixing of Troy EX 1050.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Storage between 90°F (32°C) and 32°F (0°C) is

suggested.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticides, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State pesticide or environmental control agency or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA regional office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Clean container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ½ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
